Fishing Rules

PLEASE NOTE:

No children 14 years and younger are permitted to fish anywhere on the Estate without Adult supervision at all times.

Should you not be fully competent in the art of fly fishing please ensure you have a fly fisherman with you, who is able to offer the correct procedure, especially when releasing them. The trout become extremely stressed if they are not handled correctly when releasing them back into the water and this results in them dying immediately.

Terry Winsor is always available to offer advice on fly fishing and the release of trout.

1. Only recognised fly fishing equipment maybe used
2. All flies must be barbless

3. Bag limit is 5 per stay per lodge maximum 2 per weir

4. If both lodges are occupied at the same time then only 4 rods from each lodge is allowed on the river at any one time

5. No littering – everything that is taken to the river must be returned to the lodges

6. Fishing records must be filled in

7. From Waxberry weir to end of Estate – fishing is permitted by both lodge guests.

8. No fires to be lit in picnic areas and along river
